## ROAD-CROSSING GUIDE



HOW TO USE  
THE AIR LINE'S  
CROSSING SIGNALS

**1. STOP**   
AT ALL CROSSINGS

  
beep!   
**2. PRESS**  
THE BUTTON

WAIT UNTIL IT'S SAFE TO GO...



THEN  
**3. CROSS!**  
WAVE — SAY THANKS!

# TWO KINDS OF CROSSING SIGNALS

## KNOW WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN USING THEM

**RRFB** stands for  
**R**ectangular **R**apid **F**lashing **B**eacon

- Yellow flashing lights when activated
- Cars **DO NOT** have to stop
- Press button and **WAIT** for traffic to clear or yield before you go
- Always **look both ways** first then cross safely.



PASS WITH CARE

**HAWK** stands for  
**H**igh Intensity **A**ctivated Cross**W**alk

- Yellow lights flash first, then steady yellow, then red
- Cars **MUST** stop on red, just like a regular traffic signal
- Press button and **WAIT** for traffic to stop
- Only cross safely when the white **walk sign** comes on →
- Always **look both ways** before crossing, even at a HAWK.
